All awards applications must be emailed to [CFEEA.AWARDS@gmail.com](mailto:CFEA.AWARDS@gmail.com) no later than **JULY 8, 2011.**

All facilities submitting for awards must be entered into ESPM before June 30, 2011.

Buildings applying for awards must be at least 3 years old from the date of occupancy to June 30, 2011.

The EUI **baseline** period for this competition must be set for a 12 month consecutive period beginning no earlier than January 1, 2009 and ending no later than May 31, 2010.

The **comparison** period for improvements or best performance must be for the subsequent 12 month consecutive period following the baseline period, beginning no earlier than January 1, 2010 and ending no later than May 31, 2011.

The applications will be reviewed by CFEEA ESPM Specialists for accuracy. Facility Managers listed as the point of contact may be contacted by one or more ESPM specialists for coordination of onsite verification of site data and/or utility records.

Each Building may be entered on only one awards application. A facility may be entered for both best performer and most improved in each category on the same application, but only for one building category type (Medical Office, Outpatient Care, Office, etc). Awards categories are determined by actual building designations as listed in your Portfolio Manager, determined by overall facility space type.

Awards will be offered for the following:

Best Performer: Lowest EUI or highest ENERGYSTAR score (where applicable) for each category. An overall best performer will also be selected.

Most Improved: Greatest reduction in EUI between baseline period and comparison period for each category. An overall most improved will also be selected.
